



The Pastor's Point . . .

Life is full of trials, troubles and a few triumphs along the way. We often times go along what seems to be a smooth path for a while, and then we hit a pothole that really throws us for a loop. Or maybe we are building things in our life and we have props to hold things in place, then someone or something decides to knock those props down from under us and now everything is falling. You may ask the question does God understand? Can He take this seemingly tragedy and make it into something good? Can this make me a better person? The answer is YES without any hesitation. I desire to be a blessing to you! Here are some principles to help you in this journey we call life so you will not be caught off guard when the next pothole comes your way.

I. Problems that arise when the props are kicked from under you.

You first begin with the denial stage. You say to yourself "This cannot be happening to me. So many people live in this stage and some never get out. Then we go through the disappointment stage. We can find ourselves getting disappointed in all our ambitions and abilities and then we turn that disappointment against God. Then finally there is the depression stage. II. Possible purposes for the props being kicked from under you.
